



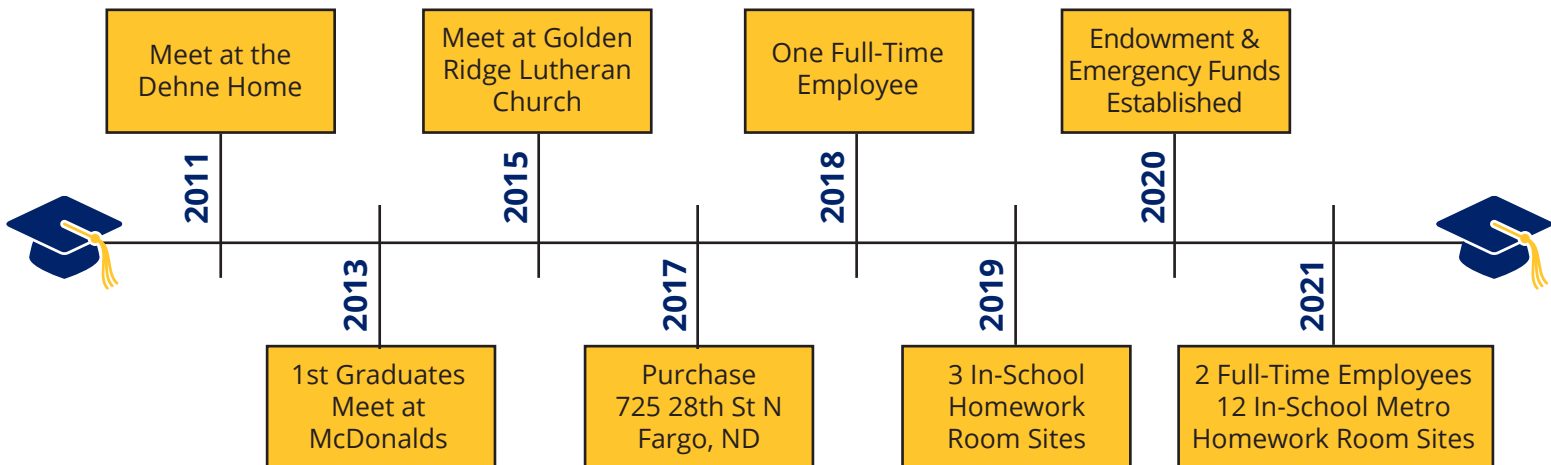

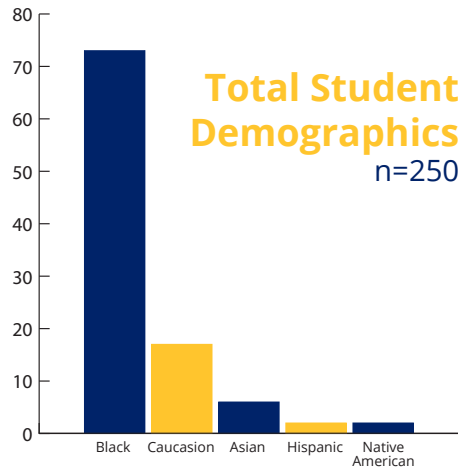
Fargo youth developed the mission and vision of LCF in 2011. It was their voices who recognized the need to invest in their futures with after-school resources.
